| 6 | there some preliminary issues here? |
| 7 | MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there is. |
| 8 | CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. |
| 9 | MS. SCHMIDT: At the outset, |
| 10 | before we go to the individuals, I would just |
| 11 | like to say that the OIC is going to consist |
| 12 | of a $\$ 15,000$ fine to be paid on March 15, 2014 |
| 13 | with a certified check, I believe. |
| 14 | MS. TODD: Yes. |
| 15 | MS. SCHMIDT: With a certified |
| 16 | check and the establishment will not reopen |
| 17 | until the payment of the fine. In other |
| 18 | words, the establishment will stay closed |
| 19 | until the payment of the fine. |
| 20 | Now, to get to specifics, this |
| 21 | case also involves cases that are not on the |
| 22 | calendar today, that is why I gave you the |

printout so you could follow along, because this is all the -- these are all the outstanding cases against TruOrleans to this date.

So that's a \$15,000 fine and the establishment remaining closed applies to all these cases.

So for Case No. -- so if you want to follow along, for the record, for Case No. 13-CMP-00303 there is a \$2,000 fine.

For Case No. 13-CMP-00261 there is a $\$ 750$ fine.

For Case No. 13-CMP-00321 there is a \$1,000 fine.

Now, I think those are the three cases that are before the Board today.

Now, here are the next group of cases, which I believe Ms. Jenkins has pulled for the Board:

Case No. 13-CMP-00145 a $\$ 750$ fine.
Case No. 13-AUD-00060 is a \$2,000
fine.

Case No. 13-251-0086 is a \$2,000 fine.

Case No. 13-CMP-363 is a \$2,000 fine, which is an outstanding amount, which is -- well, I'm sorry. The last three cases starting with 13-CMP-00363, these are fines that have not been paid and these are all to be paid.

So the first one is $\$ \mathbf{2 , 0 0 0}$ for 13 -CMP-00363. The second one is 13-AUD-00032 a \$1,000 fine. And then Case No. 11-CMP-00372 a \$2,500 fine.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: So the last three, are they what is owed or are they --

MS. SCHMIDT: They are what is
owed. They are what is owed.
CHAIRPERSON MILLER: What is owed.
MS. SCHMIDT: They are included in this \$15,000 figure.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Ms.
Todd, do you want to say anything with respect to this?

MS. TODD: The only thing I will add to that is that my client is willing to not open until they are actually -- these fines are all paid, just to show that -- you know, because the last three that are on there a good faith on their part, because they realize that previously they haven't been able to pay due to financial hardships. So they are trying to get their books in order, so that they can prevent these things from happening in the future.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And is
your client agreeable to this offer in compromise?

MS. TODD: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And you have it on a piece of paper as well what Ms. Schmidt --

MS. TODD: Yes, $I$ have everything.
CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.
MS. TODD: Everything you guys see, I see as well.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And does Mr. Redding understand that by entering into the offer in compromise, he waives his right to a hearing?

MS. TODD: Correct.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.
MR. REDDING: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Are there any questions from Board Members?

MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes. This question may be superfluous, but I'll ask it anyway. Does the licensee waive service on at least, well, on all of the first six? Because we haven't called two of those into the record and we haven't talked about service.

So does the licensee waive service on the first six cases that were read?

MS. TODD: Yes. We have received service on, $I$ believe, the first four. There is another --

not following a Board Order there, which is not -- which is --

MS. SCHMIDT: Yes. But I would like to --

MEMBER ALBERTI: But nothing has been done on those charges. Is that correct?

MS. SCHMIDT: $I$, for some reason--
MEMBER ALBERTI: But we don't know?

MS. SCHMIDT: Nothing has been done. However, I think that the intention is that in order to -- keeping the establishment closed and paying the one fine, that this will end the matter.

MEMBER ALBERTI: I understand the intent of the whole thing. I'm just trying to get -- understand where we are with this.

MS. SCHMIDT: Nothing. No -- I don't think any charges have been drafted to this point.

MEMBER ALBERTI: And we don't even know if charges are --

MS. SCHMIDT: Pending.
MEMBER ALBERTI: -- warranted.

MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, we don't even know that.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: We know the first three, because they are before us.

MEMBER ALBERTI: Right. No, I understand, but the last three. No, we are talking about the last three.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, okay.
MEMBER ALBERTI: $I$ know it's clear what Ms. Schmidt and I are talking about. We understand each other.

MS. SCHMIDT: Yes. Today we do, at least.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Other questions? Okay. Then I would move that we accept this offer in compromise of a \$15,000 fine payable by March 15, 2014. If payment is not made by March 15, 2014, the establishment will remain closed and not permitted to resume operations until payment is received by ABRA.

Do I have a second?
MEMBER BROOKS: Second.
CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those in
favor say aye?
MEMBER ALBERTI: I am --

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Aye.
MEMBER BROOKS: Aye.
MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Aye.
MEMBER ALBERTI: -- going to oppose.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All those opposed?

MEMBER ALBERTI: And I'll just say why. Actually, I mean, I understand this is a good faith effort by the owner and I appreciate that. It's just the lack of information on the pending fines that -- it's just that lack of information gives me a little uneasiness, so I'm going to oppose this. I would have rather had complete information in which I could feel completely comfortable making the decision, so I will
have to oppose on that, based on that.
MS. SCHMIDT: Mr. Alberti, I'm pretty sure that ABRA must have the records of when they were due.

MEMBER ALBERTI: Oh, I'm sure they do.

MS. SCHMIDT: They must have them.
MEMBER ALBERTI: I'm sure they do, but we don't have them before us right now and I have to move forward.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I
believe then the vote is 3-1-0 to accept the offer in compromise with Mr. Alberti opposing. Okay. We will have an order for you here in a minute.

MS. TODD: Okay. Thank you.
CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I mean, we
will be issuing actually a more formal order. Because of the global nature of this settlement, we will be issuing a fuller written order and we will be sending it to you electronically.
