



## FY2022 AND FY2023 EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) ACTION PLAN

### Substantial Amendment

The Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD), the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development’s (HUD’s) primary point of contact for Consolidated Planning, on behalf of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHS), has drafted a substantial amendment for the FY 2022 and FY 2023 Annual Action plans. The purpose of the substantial amendment is to notify the public that DHS will allocate up to sixty percent of the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) to spend on expenses for emergency shelters.

In accordance with the District’s Citizen Participation Plan, the District is required to provide a 30-day comment period and host a public hearing to discuss the change. The comment period will begin on July 14, 2023, and end at 5:00 pm on August 14, 2023.

The District will submit the proposed amendment and all public comments to HUD by August 16, 2023, through the Integrated Disbursement and Information System (IDIS).
