JUNE HOUSING BLOOM

Mayor Muriel Bowser and several District of Columbia agencies have kicked off the first annual June Housing Bloom, a month-long initiative that showcases how the public and private sectors are partnering to both produce and preserve affordable housing across the city, and to revitalize neighborhoods. Events will spotlight five key priorities:

1. Producing affordable housing
2. Preserving affordable housing
3. Increasing homeownership
4. Ending homelessness
5. Finding solutions to vacant and blighted properties
