Office of Tenant Advocate

(Legal Assistance & Education and Outreach)

OTA advises tenants on resolving disputes with landlords, and provides legal and technical assistance for further action such as filing tenant petitions. The **Education & Community** Outreach team provides tenants and Tenant Associations with educational materials, classes, and virtual tutorials on issues that matter to District renters, and participates in community events and activities.



(Homeownership and Rental Opportunities)

A platform that connects residents to housing-related resources, focusing on supporting individuals in becoming and succeeding as DC homeowners, while also offering information on Inclusionary Zoning (IZ) rental opportunities. Hosted by DMPED.

DHS Intake Centers & Hotline

(Emergency & Transitional Opportunities)

The Virginia Williams Family Resource Center (VWFRC) serves as the central intake for families in need of housing support in D.C., providing emergency rental assistance, homeless diversion services, family shelter placement, and community-based resources. Families experiencing homelessness should contact VWFRC for guidance, while individuals in need of immediate assistance can visit a DHS day service center. If visiting in person is not possible, they should reach out to the DHS Shelter Hotline for emergency shelter.



DCHA Service Centers

(Rental Opportunities and Public Housing)

At DCHA's Service Centers, applicants, participants and landlords can meet in person with DCHA staff, who will address their questions. The Centers are also available for applicants, participants and landlords to drop off documents related to rental housing assistance.
